Campaigning, Individual Endorsements and Board Endorsement Policies For KCDP Officers

Partisan Races:

Pre-primary:

Individual Officers of the Kenosha County Democratic Party and the Kenosha County Democratic Party as a whole will make no pre-primary endorsements of Democratic candidates.

Officers should not publicly support a candidate pre-primary, which includes social media posts promoting one candidate over another and publicly working on a campaign.

Post-Primary:

Full public support and campaign work by Officers is allowed.

The KCDP Board will make endorsements on a case by case basis and if a candidate agrees to the endorsement.

Non-partisan races:

Pre-primary:

Individual Officers will make no public support pre-primary which includes social media posts and publicly working on a campaign unless:

- 1. the state Party makes an endorsement, or
- 2. KCDP Officers vote to make an endorsement as a board.

Post Primary:

If multiple Democratic candidates are running against each other for the same seat, the pre-primary rules apply.
